Mahabad: Two Kurdish Brothers Arrested, One of Whom a 13-Year-Old Child

Two Kurdish brothers, including a 13-year-old child named Mardin Rasoulzadeh and Ehsan Rasoulzadeh, have been arrested by the Iranian security forces and transferred to an unknown location.

According to a report received by the Hengaw Organization for Human Rights, on Wednesday, August 14, 2024, Ehsan Rasoulzadeh, 22 years old, along with his brother, Mardin Rasoulzadeh, 13 years old, were arrested during a raid by the Iranian Intelligence forces on their family home in the "Esahabeh Sepi" neighborhood of Mahabad and were transferred to an unknown location.

According to informed sources, the Rasoulzadeh family's efforts to find out the fate of their sons have so far been unsuccessful, and security agencies have refused to provide a clear response on the matter.

As of the time of this report, there is no accurate information available regarding the reasons for their arrest, the charges brought against them, their place of detention, or their current **condition**.¹

2-Arezo Badri is in death situation

Report on the Latest Situation of Arezoo Badri, a Young Woman, Victim of Compulsory Hijab Enforcement in Iran

Arezoo Badri, a young woman who was targeted by direct gunfire from the Iranian security forces in connection with "compulsory hijab," has undergone a second surgery at Valiasr Hospital in Tehran. Her health condition has deteriorated, and her family is under pressure.

According to a report by Hengaw, on Wednesday, August 14, 2024, Arezoo Badri underwent her second surgery, this time at Valiasr Hospital in Tehran, due to fluid accumulation in her lungs (pulmonary edema). She had previously undergone surgery at a hospital in Sari.

It is said that during her first surgery, which was necessary due to a bullet hitting her back, she lost the ability to move from the waist down, and the possibility of her regaining her health seems very unlikely.

The family of this victim of the Iran's Islamic compulsory hijab policy is currently under pressure from Iranian security agencies to recite dictated narratives in front of the camera. This goal might be achieved in the coming days through increased pressure.

According to the latest reports, Arezoo Badri's car had been listed for confiscation under the pretext of "not observing hijab," which was the reason it was targeted by the officers.

State-affiliated media, without mentioning details, claimed that the reason for shooting at this young woman's car was "police suspicion" and "failure to heed a stop command."

On Tuesday, July 23, 2024, Arezoo Badri, approximately 31 years old and the mother of two children, was shot in the back while driving in Noor city, Mazandaran province, by direct fire from Iranian security forces.

After being shot, Arezoo Badri was transferred to a hospital in Noor and then to Khomeini Hospital in Sari. Eventually, due to the severity of her condition, she was transferred to Vali Asr Hospital in Tehran, where she is also under surveillance by the Iranian security **forces.**²

Sarvnaz Ahmadi in death situation



Iranian Writers Association: Sarvnaz Ahmadi, a translator and member of the Iranian Writers Association, was sent to a neurologist from Evin prison on Tuesday, August 13, 2024. ».

While announcing this news, the relatives of Sarvnaz added that the "trusted doctor of the judiciary" also described his condition as "very serious" and requested an emergency leave for Soronaz.

According to one of Sarovnaz's relatives, "she has completed a third of his three-and-a-half-year prison sentence, and according to the law, she has the possibility to use leave and parole, but the security officers do not allow her to use these rights."

Sarvanaz Ahmadi suffered a "nervous attack, convulsion and severe muscle contraction" last week following the attack of the prison guard forces on the protest of women political prisoners. After being sent to the hospital, she was returned to the prison while the treating doctors had diagnosed anxiety and the possibility of another nervous attack as dangerous for her.

Sarvanaz was arrested during the "Women, Life, Freedom" movement on November 6, 2022 and transferred to Evin prison. In the end, she was sentenced to 3 years and six months in prison for the charges of "assembly and collusion with the intention of disrupting national security" and "propaganda against the regime".^{3,4}

Sara Jahani is in danger of dying

Sara Jahani, a women's rights activist, who is serving her sentence in Lakan prison in Rasht with unfavorable physical conditions, has been deprived of specialized medical treatment due to the lack of permission from the prison authorities.

Sara Jahani lost her balance due to a muscle spasm, fell to the ground, and suffered injuries to her head and face in Lakan Prison.

Despite this, the prison officials not only did not send him to the medical centers, but also did not allow the medical doctor to visit her, and it was enough to put a few stitches on her wounds by a medical doctor.

At the same time, she needs an acute and specialized care due to the severity of the bleeding and laceration above the eye and must be taken to a hospital outside the prison for a medical examination.

Sara Jahani, who is suffering from MS disease, was arrested on August 8 of 2024 to serve her sentence and was transferred to Lakan prison in Rasht.

This women's rights activist was arrested by the security forces in Gilan province in August 2023, and was released two months later after bail. In March of 2024, she and 10 other civil activists of Gilan were sentenced to more than 60 years in prison in a joint case.^{5,6}
